### **MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS:**

Members meeting all safety council rebate eligibility requirements have the opportunity to earn a 2% and/or 2% rebate on BWC Premiums. Our monthly sessions focus on Safety and Health and also offer access to BWC and OSHA administrators, as well as networking opportunities.

#### **Employers must meet all of the following eligibility requirements to earn rebates:**

- Enroll with paperwork and payment to the Northern Cincinnati Safety Council by **JULY 31, 2018**.
- Attend 10 meetings or events, at least 8 through NCSC. Employer has the option to gain credit for up to two meetings through attendance at BWC's Division of Safety & Hygiene (DSH) safety training courses or industry-specific training.
- CEO (or highest ranking Southern Ohio authority) must attend one NCSC sponsored meeting (CEO attendance counts as credit toward one of 10 meetings required).
- Submit two semi-annual reports on time

#### **Member Fees:**

- Sharonville Chamber or NCSC Returning Members receive a 25% discount. Final cost \$150
- New Non-Member Annual Fee for NCSC is \$200.
- Annual Dues: Applications and Payments must be received by July 31<sup>st</sup> for the 2018-2019 year

#### **Location/Time:**

- Sharonville Fire House, Training Room, 11637 Chester Rd., just north of Kemper Rd.

#### **Benefit Details:**

Employers not enrolled in a group-experience rating program have the opportunity to earn a 2% participation rebate on their premium. To earn this rebate, employers must meet program eligibility requirements in one of 81 BWC-sponsored safety councils. \* These enrollees can earn an additional 2% performance bonus rebate. To earn this performance bonus, employers must reduce either the severity or frequency of injuries in their workplace by 10% or maintain both at zero. (\* The rebate offer excludes self-insuring employers, state agencies and employers enrolled in BWC's group retrospective program. Employers enrolled in a group-experience rating program are eligible for the 2% performance bonus only. Limitations apply to a professional employer organization.)

Group-experience-rating program-employers who meet program eligibility requirements in one of 81 BWC-sponsored safety councils, can earn a 2% performance bonus rebate. To earn this performance bonus, these employers must fulfill all of the eligibility requirements below as well as reduce either the severity or frequency of injuries in their workplace by 10% or maintain both at zero.
