Back by popular demand, our parade will once again start at the corner of Reading and Sharon Road in Downtown Sharonville. But, for the first time ever, we are excited to tell you that the parade will be following the entire Downtown Sharonville Loop! This is your chance to be part of a new twist on a Sharonville tradition. This year's theme is "**Celebrate Sharonville's Heroes**". There are lots of ways to join in on the fun:

- Enter a float, classic car, marchers, mascots, musical groups, or performers into the parade. (Open to all businesses, churches, & community organizations.)

- Join your parade unit immediately following the parade at Depot Square for an awards ceremony where will be recognizing our best parade participants!

Lineup for the parade will begin at 1:30pm for all parade units & participants. Step off will begin promptly at 2:00pm. Participants are encouraged to park in the public parking lots located behind Depot Square or at the Sharonville Community Center.

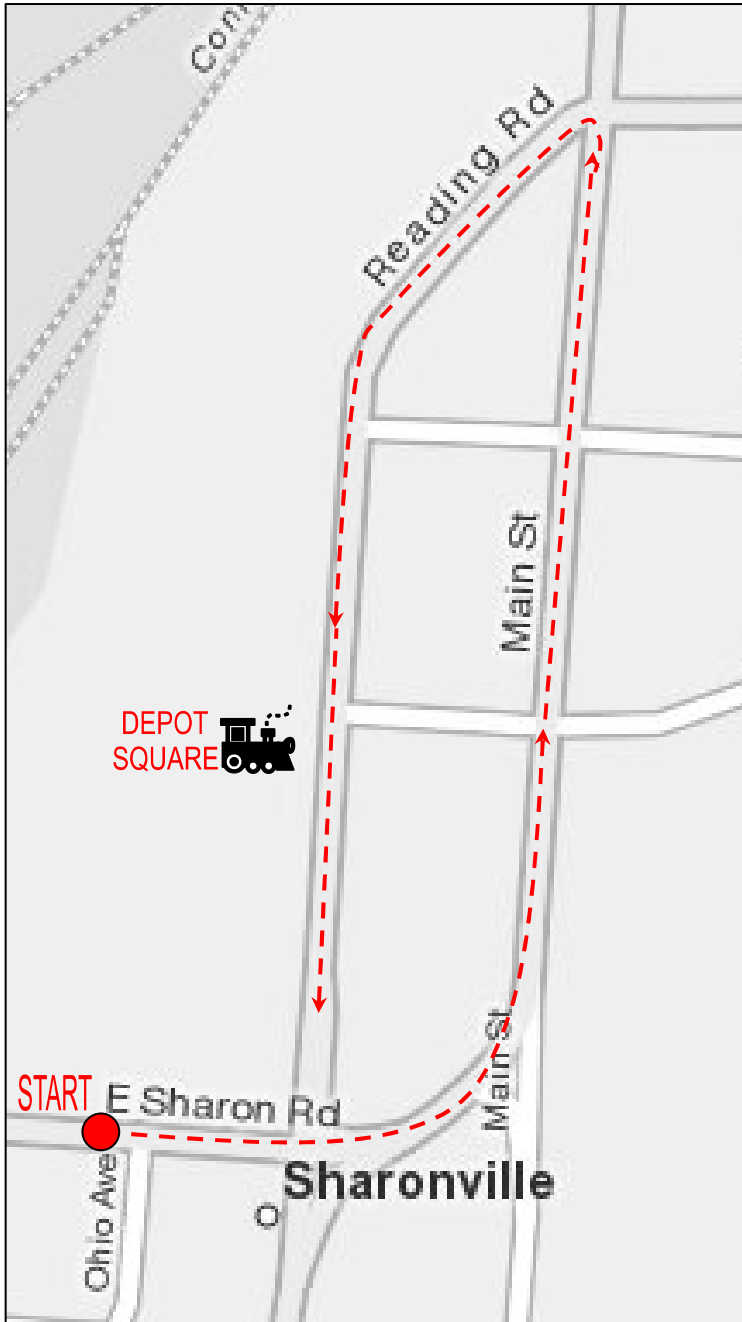

PARADE ROUTE

Lineup will begin on Sharon Road. The parade will begin on the corner of Sharon and Reading Road (VFW Hall). You will travel down Main Street. Take Main Street to the intersection of Main Street, Reading Road, and Cornell Road. Turn LEFT onto Reading Road (beginning the second half of the loop). The parade will end close to depot square. Some floats will be directed to public parking near depot square and others will be directed to the VFW Hall.
