Quilted Treasures

July 22-23, 12 p.m.-8 p.m. and July 24, 10 a.m.-5 p.m.

SHARONVILLE, Ohio – Heritage Village Museum and Educational Center is hosting Quilted Treasures on July 22 through 23 from 12 p.m. to 8 p.m. and July 24 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Many people have an old quilt passed down to them from their mother. It might be a treasured family heirloom or for everyday use. Originally quilts were used to prevent waste and ensure warmth during the winter. Later, people made special quilts for wedding gifts or to chronologize family history. Quilting Bees allowed women to gather and socialize while creating beautiful pieces of history.

The beautiful history of quilts will be on display during our Quilted Treasures event and attendees will get to learn more about the complex art of quilting. We will have quilts from our own collection and some that the Warren County and Butler County historical societies have generously loaned. We would also like to thank our sponsor Bob Coon from Seams Sew Easy sewing center, who is also loaning 39 quilts for display. Admission is \$10 per adult, \$5 per child ages 5-11, and free for members and children ages 4 and under.

Heritage Village Museum and Educational Center is operated by Historic Southwest Ohio (HSO), a private, non-profit organization that owns and operates the buildings and collections of Heritage Village Museum and Educational Center. Heritage Village Museum and Educational Center is a picturesque gathering of 13 authentic historical buildings that represent various aspects of family life during the 1800s. These buildings include historic homes, a train station, a doctor's office, a general store, and a church.
